# Status of the priority list

- 5<sup>th</sup> MIG: mandate for MIWP action 2016.5 “Priority list of datasets for eReporting” endorsed.
- A specific [wiki page](#) has been created for action 2016.5.
  - **a stable version 1.0 of the priority list**
  - **MIG mandate for the action**
  - **the working document v4.0 (excel file with detailed information).**
  - **Feedback or ideas about improving publication/version management are welcome.**
- Priority list v1.0
  - **Based on feedback from MIG, Eionet, DG ENV policy units**
  - **44 unique reporting data sets fulfilling 49 regulatory reporting obligations coming from 20 different legal acts within the acquis of DG ENV;**

# Status of the 2016.5 subgroup

- The invitation for nomination was sent out on 20/03, deadline for nomination is 28/04.
- the MIG platform for discussing the priority list will be complemented by the Eionet National Focal Point workgroup (NFP WG) on INSPIRE
  - **To avoid potential duplication between the work of [Eionet](#) and INSPIRE MIG experts**
  - **Strengthen the collaboration between reporting and INSPIRE communities**
  - **Provide a platform for exchanging knowledge and building a common understanding for INSPIRE implementation in support of possible eReporting.**
- Subgroup commitment will stretch beyond 2020, covering short- to long-term INSPIRE and eReporting tasks.
- A first physical meeting of this combined expert subgroup will be organised as part of the INSPIRE conference on 4th or 5th September 2017 in Kehl, Germany.

# Ongoing related activities

- 2016.2 - Indicator on the availability of data sets on the priority list.
  - **Discussion on filtering data sets from the list or matching other criteria (e.g. open data, national datasets) using metadata.**
- EC & EEA INSPIRE team is taking care of internal coordination and is preparing the ground for further implementation and development of the priority list. Ongoing discussion and collaboration with DG ENV policy units on
  - **Emissions**
  - **NOISE**
  - **Nature & Biodiversity** (initial focus on CDDA as pilot to test some principles)
  - **Invasive Alien Species**
  - **Detailed status update on these initiatives tomorrow “INSPIRE pilots and demonstrators”**
