Description

Dear Christina, On 21st May 2018 Sweden changed the National Discovery Service endpoint but the Network Services still contains old links to the dataset metadata which are still pointing to the old endpoint, still active, which returns old and incorrect versions of the same dataset metadata. I checked one case and from the Atom service they point to an older version of the dataset metadata, which has a wrong citation and the theme is not recognised so is not picked in the query.

It is correct that we have update to a new CSW-Endpoint.
